Collection Schedules will change on **Monday, July 13, 2009!**

WHAT'S **NOT** CHANGING?

- » USING trashcans with tight-fitting lids - it's required by law. USE the ones you already have. If you don't have at least one now - please get one.
- » Unlimited yard waste (leaves, grass clippings, shrub clippings.) is still okay. It can be bagged or bundled and set out next to your cans on trash collection day. Please don't mix trash with yard waste.
- » Bulk trash service - you can still call 311 to schedule curbside collection of 3 items per month.

WHAT **IS** CHANGING?

- » Your days of service.
- » Your time of collection.
 - Beginning **July 13**, the City will collect waste Tuesday through Friday. Saturday will be the automatic make up collection for holidays that fall on a collection day. (There will be no collections on July 13)
 - Beginning **July 13**, to insure pick up, set out your cans no later than 6 a.m.
 - You may set your trash out the night before as long as it's in a can with a lid.
 - You will set out your recycling at the same place you set out your trash.
- » You will still have two collections BUT one will be for trash, AND one will be for recycling only. Trash will be limited to 96 gallons per week AND recycling will be **UNLIMITED**.
